Policy 2018-0409**

Designating the Clock to be Used to Open and Close the Polls

Town of Sumner

Title and Purpose: This Policy, #2018-0409, *Designating the Clock to be Used to Open and Close the Polls*, is enacted to maintain compliance and consistency with s. 6.78 (1m) Wis. Stats that states: *The polls at every election shall be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m.*

Authority: The Town Board of the Town of Sumner has the general authority under s.60.22 Wis. Stats. to enact this policy related to Chapter 6, specifically 6.78 Wis. Stats. and as may be amended or repealed and recreated by State of Wisconsin legislative action.

Adoption of Policy: The Town Board of the Town of Sumner, Jefferson County, Wisconsin on a roll-call vote with a quorum present and voting, and proper notice having been given, do adopt this Policy as follows:

Designating Official Clock for Polls: The clock to be used by the Chief Inspector at every election to open and close polls is to be located at the west wall of the town meeting hall. In the event the designated clock becomes inoperable in advance of an election, the Chief Inspector shall designate a clock to be used in advance of the opening of the polls.

Effective Date:

This Policy shall take effect after passage and adoption by the Town Board and posting as required under s. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
